But I am unaware of what laws and rules govern this potential


motion. Am I supposed to have it raised as PCR or Direct Appeal issue? I do not know; I am asking for your knowledge, not your advice. If you can help guide me towards the proper rules, cases, laws, etc. that pertains to that Prima Facie showing and the applicable motions and formats, I will read and research them myself.

I realize you are very familiar with this process and the procedures which needs to be implemented. I am not. Given all the basic information that I have provided to you (with the exception of my own suggestions and personal takes on the law) where should I be concentrating my efforts to effectively raise this issue of juror misconduct?



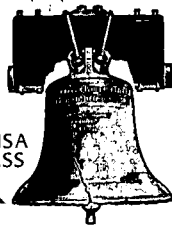

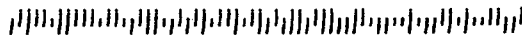
