NOW COMES Appellant, William McFarland, by and through his undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, and moves this Honorable Court for an extension of time to Monday, December 21, 2020, to file/serve his initial brief and corresponding designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.
