ORDER

The South Carolina Court of Appeals denied the petition for a writ of certiorari in this post-conviction relief (PCR) case. Petitioner has now filed a notice of appeal seeking review of that decision, which this Court construes as a petition for a writ of certiorari to review the decision of the Court of Appeals.

In *Ellison v. State*, 382 S.C. 189, 676 S.E.2d 671 (2009), this Court determined that it will no longer entertain petitions for writs of certiorari where the Court of Appeals has denied a petition for a writ of certiorari in a PCR case. Accordingly, the petition for a writ of certiorari is dismissed.
