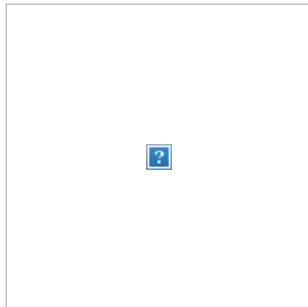

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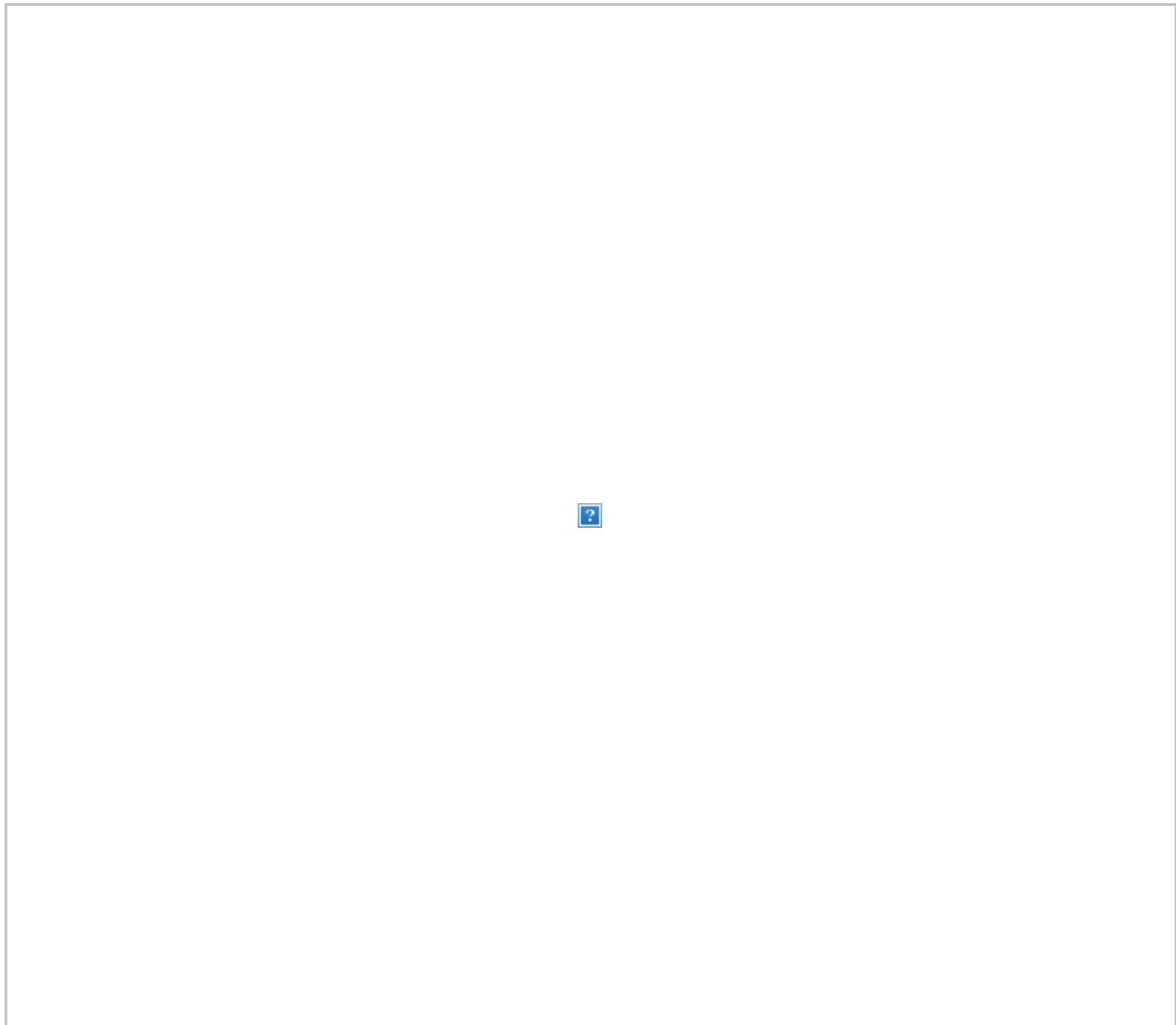

Good afternoon. I processed your OneDrive request a few moments. It was for your existing OneDrive folder created on 12/2/20. I do know that if you don't access the folder using the link in the email that is sent out within a certain time it will not work. Please let me know if you have not been able to access your folder with the new email I sent out.

However, for filings that are not large (such as motions and petitions, and the extension request you just submitted) you can use this address to file by email. OneDrive works well for Records on appeal and Appendices. As the respondent, you likely won't be required to file anything like that.

Hi and happy holidays.

My client won his PCR case in the 9th circuit and then the AGs office appealed, so we are on our way to you guys. I think that makes us the Respondent for the Sup Ct case.

In any event, I know I have 30 days from the filing of the Petition for Writ to file a return.

I had previously requested permission to file with the Supreme Court through the AIS link and received the email. However, today I wanted to file a request for extension (our due day, I believe, would be Monday and I didn't want to wait until the last minute) and the email I was sent is marked all up with phishing blocks from Google. I do not know if it is because I did not go ahead and verify within a certain time frame of receiving the sharepointe email (on 02 December) or if it is just google.

I requested again through AIS hoping a new email would be sent. I am still awaiting the email (admittedly, it has only been 7 minutes). I am attaching my request for extension to this email, although I am pretty sure that this is not the proper way to file it. I just wanted it there in case I do not receive another email from sharepointe for registration into the OneDrive for Business access.

Thank you in advance for any assistance in fixing this dilemma with the OneDrive/sharepointe emails through AIS.
