COMES NOW Miguel Lutron Bryan, non-absentee, non- assumpit, who is not a ward, I am sui juris, who is before this exclusive, original jurisdiction surrogate/court of ordinary/probate court by special limited appearance only without waving any right, remedies or defenses statutorial or procedural. This motion is under the authority of the power of appointment act of 1951 and SC Code 62-1-302 (a)(1)(3)(4). All future implied prescriptive intermeddling is hereby estopped, by all executors de son tort 62-3-619 that are required to post bond. I rebut all presumptions of death (civiliter mortuus) and the like by my intent and competency, with law points and authorities of case precedents on the doctrine of mortmain /absentee,

Leading Case on this matter. It is the landmark United States Supreme Court precedents about the return of the absentee See Scott v. McNeal, 154 U.S. 34 (1894); a court of probate (basically all administrative courts) has no jurisdiction over the estate of a person who is in fact alive cf. Presbyterian church v Louis Union Trust Co. (1974), 18 ILL App.3d 713)

“ the power of the court to grant letters of administration exists only when the person whose estate is sought to be administered is dead (civiliter mortuus est). And if he is not dead, the authorities are almost unanimous in holding that a grant of administration or probate of a will, and all proceedings thereunder, are void. (See exhibit A of Abandoned paperwork)

This is actual and constructive notice that the undersigned is in fact alive and this express notice and motion is to notice this court of the rebuttal of the presumption of the undersigned being missing, this motion and notice of revocation of summary administration concerning estopple of the implied prescriptive intermeddling is effective immediately ...

Summary Notes on Executors and Estates, directly cited from CJS 1941, updates thru 1998

SECTION 16, PAGE 892: FACT OF DEATH: Death of a person on whose estate administration is sought is a jurisdiction requisite; and while the presumption of death arising from absence may present a prima facie case sufficient to warrant a grant of administration, yet if subsequently develops that such person was in fact alive, the administration is void. ANY ADMINISTRATION ON THE ESTATE OF A LIVING PERSON IS VOID.

"administration" is the management of the estate of a decedent and expresses the jurisdiction assumed by the proper court over it.

The "estate" of a deceased person (personality) is not a legal entity but is merely a name indicating the sum total of the decedent's assets and liabilities...and is not an entity known to the law, and is not a natural or an artificial person, but is merely a name of the sum total of the assets. Note 43, page 881: "Estate" is generally used as meaning property belonging to a decedent, a ward, a mentally incompetent person or a bankrupt, and which is being administered in the courts (all statutory administrative courts).

Page 554: The presumption of death is effective for practically all legal purposes, including proceedings involving real property, and is available as a method of proof of death (civil) in a case where death is a jurisdictional fact that must be made to appear.

Judicial Cognizance to be taken in favor of the undersigned as the undersigned trustor/settlor is competent to handle his own affairs/ sui juris, the newly appointed trustee Irwin G. Condon is to discharge any and all debts via as the undersigned has a right to be subrogation as the donor/beneficiary of any and all securities of the minor account and the like by operation of law under the color of law..

The newly appointed trustee is to inform the Department of Corrections to immediately release the undersigned from being held under duress as the undersigned as specially reappeared and is not absent in law ("presumption of civiliter mortuus"). As the probate/court/ordinary has exclusive, original jurisdiction over trust and estates. 



Did within this County and State on the 5th day of March 2015, did violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particulars:

VIOLATION OF SECTION

The affiant states there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth, and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

That on March 5, 2015, while at the International Lounge, located at 4620 Dorchester Road in the City of North Charleston, County of Charleston, State of South Carolina, the defendant, Miguel Lutron BRYAN, did commit the offense of Trafficking Cocaine, in violation of section 44-53-370 (c)(2)(a) of the South Carolina Code of Laws of 1976, as amended. In that the defendant did willfully and unlawfully distribute approximately 13.60 grams of a white powder substance, which tested positive as cocaine by the Department of Homeland Security, U.S. Customs and Border Protection Laboratories and Scientific Services lab in Savannah, GA.

Facts to establish the aforesaid are that an undercover agent (UC) with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) and an ATF confidential informant (CI) conducted an undercover purchase of a quantity of cocaine from BRYAN in the area of 4620 Dorchester Road in the City of North Charleston. The ATF UC agent gave the defendant a quantity pre-recorded ATF buy funds in exchange for 13.60 grams of white powder substance, which field tested presumptive for containing cocaine. The transaction was audio and video recorded.

This is based on an investigation by ATF and witnesses to be named in court on a later date. All against the peace and dignity of the State of South Carolina.

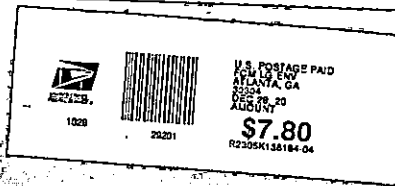
