COURT RULES



Thank you in advance for your consideration and I look forward to continuing to work with you.

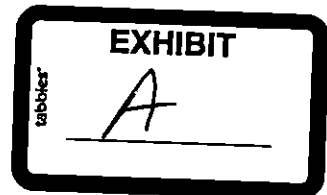


