MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE INITIAL BRIEF AND APPENDIX
(Second Request For An Extension)

Appellant, Alonzo C. Jeter, III, respectfully request an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Appendix. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, Appellant shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Appendix is due to be served and filed with the Court on or about December 30, 2020.
2. Appellant respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time.
3. Appellant has experienced a sudden move within the institution due to maintenance project being carried out at the institution

Due to the moves, (including a previous move due to Covid-19 quarantine), Appellant's files, research progress, etc involving the issue(s) which Appellant will be briefing has become mixed with other inmates' property and also mixed with Appellant's own property. Due to circumstances this was not preventable.

Appellant has also previously informed this Court the barriers which exist in composing documents which are to be filed with the courts. (E.g., SCDC's policy which restricts inmates from printing, photocopying, etc documents and which forces inmates to handwrite multiple copies, etc.)


Appellant also has only recently established contact with South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense, Division of Appellate Defense, whereby he has attempted to learn the proper party from the agency whom he is to coordinate with pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court. Appellant did establish this contact on December 22, 2020. (See also Appellant's correspondence copied to this Court whereby he has sought to inform this Court of his efforts to establish this contact).

Appellant needs an extension of time that he can compose a meaningful brief upon performing adequate research on the issues).

4. Appellant makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay as he has demonstrated due diligence throughout.
5. Counsel for the Attorney General's Office has been informed of this request.

WHEREFORE, Appellant would respectfully request a (30) thirty-

day extension in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Appellant request that the time of the extension in which it runs, should this Court grant this motion, begin to run no sooner than December 30, 2020. Appellant requests that time limits for filing the Initial Brief of Appellant and Appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.

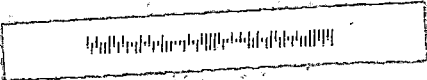
