
Dear Mr. Simmons:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$250.00.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- A proof of service showing that a copy has been served on the agency and/or the Administrative Law Court has not been provided as required by Rule 203(e), SCACR.
- The document has not been signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.
- The content of the notice of appeal is not in compliance with Rule 203(e), SCACR. Specifically, the notice of appeal shall contain the following

information: 1. Name of the agency and the name of the Administrative Law Judge. 2. The docket number of the case before the Administrative Law Court. 3. The date of the decision from which the appeal is taken and the date of when the appealing party received said decision. 4. The names and designation of all parties. 5. The names, mailing addresses of all attorneys of record and the names of the party represented by each.
