Dear Ms. Allen:

Thank you for taking the time to speak to me today. As we discussed, I represent the Respondents in the above appeal. Debbie Everett was our court reporter. Despite repeated efforts to obtain the transcript or tapes from her, we have never received any response.

It is my understanding that recently the Supreme Court issued an Order requiring her to transfer all of her materials to the Court. In the hopes that the tapes/transcript materials from our trial have been included in the submission to the Court, I write with the following information on the trial that Ms. Everett reported for.

This case was tried in Beaufort County before the Honorable Roger M. Young, Sr. The original case name caption within the circuit court was: *South Carolina Electric & Gas v. Evva S. Anderson and Michael S. Anderson*; C/A No.: 2008-CP-07-4113. Tom Mikell, Esquire, represented SCE&G and I represented the Andersons in this one (1) day trial. We struck a jury on April 16, 2012 and the entire trial (openings to verdict) occurred on April 17, 2012.

If there is any more identifying information that I can provide to you, I will be happy to do so. Please let me know if the information is located and if so, what the procedure will be for obtaining the transcript.

For the sake of completeness, I should also point out that Ms. Everett requested – and on May 15, 2012, I sent to her – payment of \$650.00 for the transcript which has never been received. I would certainly love to know whether Court Administration could be of assistance in recouping that cost.
