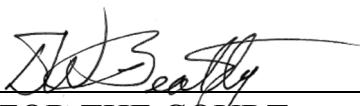

ORDER

Petitioner is requesting a fifth extension to serve and file the explanation required by Rule 243(c) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), alleging the extraordinary circumstance of a COVID-19 quarantine in petitioner's correctional institution.
