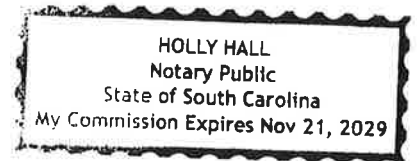

3. The State of my condition before and after the pandemic has made this process difficult I pray the court have leniency and grant my humble request.

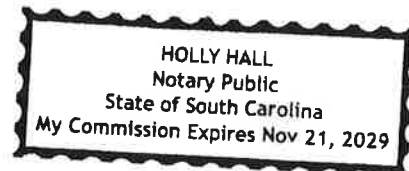

Motion for extension of time to complete Record of Appeal

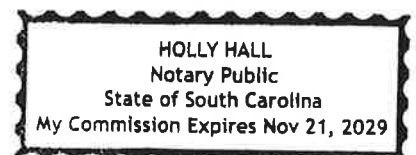
