
**NOTICE OF MOTION FOR AUTHORIZATION TO HAVE

YOU WILL PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that upon the affidavit of John Garvin, sworn to on the 8th day of January, 2021, a Motion will be made upon this Court, for an Order granting the authorization to have the expense of obtaining the transcript of Appellant, John Garvin’s PCR hearing from which a judgment has not been entered in this action was held on the 19th and continued on the 31st day of July, 2019.
