
NOW COMES THE DEFENDANT, Carolina Auto Credit / Colleen Bartona, by and through the undersigned Counsel, respectfully asking this Court to reconsider its decision in the above-referenced case.

On March 9, 2020, the Plaintiff filed a complaint against Defendant seeking damages from Defendant regarding an alleged breach of warranty involving the sale of an automobile. Defendant filed an answer to the complaint, and the hearing on the merits was scheduled for August 10, 2020. Due to a clerical error on the part of a part-time, former employee at the undersigned firm, notice documents were not sent to the Court, and Defendant and her Counsel were not present at the hearing. The Court then entered a default judgment against Defendant in the amount of \$7,420.00. The Defendant then motioned the Court to vacate the judgment pursuant to Rule 60 of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure, and the Court denied Defendant's motion.
