ORDER

By order dated January 13, 2021, this post-conviction relief (PCR) matter was dismissed after petitioner failed to provide the explanation required by Rule 243(c) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). On January 15, 2021, petitioner filed the required Rule 243(c), SCACR, explanation. The matter is reinstated, and the Court will proceed with a review of the written explanation pursuant to Rule 243(c), SCACR.

In the explanation required by Rule 243(c), SCACR, petitioner has failed to show there is an arguable basis for asserting that the determination by the lower court was improper. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
