

ORDER



ORDER

This appeal arises out of orders of the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Full Commission denying Appellant's motions to supplement the record and add parties as respondents. Because a final order has not been issued by the Commission and this case remains pending below, this appeal is dismissed. *See Bone v. U.S. Food Service*, 404 S.C. 67, 84, 744 S.E.2d 552, 561 (2013) (finding the Administrative Procedures Act (APA) governs appeals in administrative cases and dismissing interlocutory appeals pursuant to the APA). The remittitur will be sent as provided in Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
