VIRGINIA, THE PETITIONER DID NOT RECEIVE THE

FIRST LETTER FROM THE COURTS DUE TO THE TRANSFER.

THE SECOND LETTER WAS FORWARDED FROM LEWISBURG.

THE PETITIONER RECEIVE THE COURT LETTER LATE
DUE TO LEWISBURG PRISON FORWARDING THE MAIL
LATE. WHEN THE PETITIONER ARRIVED AT FCI GIL-
MER, HE COULD NOT CONTACT THE COURTS TO UPDATE HIS
ADDRESS DUE TO NOT HAVING THE COURT ADDRESS AND
CASE NUMBER THAT IS IN HIS PROPERTY. THE PETI-
TIONER HAS NOT RECEIVED HIS PROPERTY DUE TO THIS
PRISON HAVING ALOT OF ACTIVE COVID-19 CASES HERE.
THE PRISON IS CURRENTLY ON LOCKDOWN DUE TO COVID.
THE PETITIONER CANNOT SUPPLY THE COURTS THE DOCU-
MENTS THAT THE COURTS ASK FOR AT THE MOMENT DUE
TO THE DOCUMENTS BEING IN HIS PROPERTY AND THE
PRISON'S NOT PASSING THE PROPERTY OUT UNTIL THE

PRISON COME OFF OF LOCKDOWN. ALSO NOTE THAT PETITIONER DO NOT HAVE ANY LEGAL ACCESS TO THE LAW LIBRARY FOR LEGAL RESEARCH. THERE IS SOME INFORMATION ON THE LETTER THAT THE COURTS REQUESTED THAT THE PETITIONER DO NOT UNDERSTAND AND NEED TO DO FURTHER RESEARCH ON BUT CAN'T, BECAUSE THIS PRISON HAS BEEN ON LOCK DOWN FOR OVER SIX MONTHS NOW DUE TO COVID-19, THE PETITIONER FEELS THAT HE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO REPRESENT HIMSELF PROPERLY BEFORE THE COURTS WITHOUT LAW LIBRARY ACCESS. IN ADDITION TO THE EXTENDING THE TIME, THE PETITIONER ALSO ASK THE COURTS TO APPOINT LEGAL COUNSEL DUE TO NOT HAVING LEGAL ACCESS AND HAVING A LEARNING DISORDER AND

REASONS, THE PETITIONER ASK THE COURT TO ACCEPT
THIS MOTION. ALSO NOTE THAT BECAUSE OF PRISON
STAFF SHORTEST. HERE, THE PETITIONER IS HAVING
A HARD TIME GETTING STAMPS TO WRITE TO THE
COURTS,

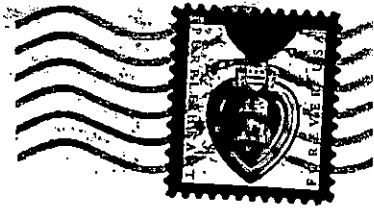
