Counsel filed the Anders brief and record on appeal in the case of State v. Pamela Tackett with the Court of Appeals on October 21, 2020. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of Brian Willie Benson Lewis v. State with the Supreme Court on October 16, 2020. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Eric Charles Peterson with the Court of Appeals on September 25, 2020. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Curtis Allen Babb, Jr. with the Court of Appeals on September 23, 2020. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Yusuf Aquil v. State with the Supreme Court on September 9, 2020.


3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay.


