MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for petitioner respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for petitioner respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Heyward Martin with this Court on December 31, 2020. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Francisco Rodriguez v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on December 3, 2020. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Dequan Vereen v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on December 3, 2020.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, has graciously consented to this extension request by way of the thirty day general consent granted by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through February 28, 2021. That emailed general consent was dated January 26, 2021.


WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty day extension, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case based upon
