MOTION TO STAY

Appellant, Alonzo C. Jeter, III, hereby respectfully moves that this Court would issue an Order which would stay this case.

Appellant informs the Court that there are pending actions that affect this case and issues thereof globally. Appellant seeks to challenge the constitutionality of S.C. Code Ann. 44-53-470 by way of filed action Alonzo C. Jeter, III v State, App. Case No. 2020-001147 (SC Supreme Ct.); Appellant has a pending PCR matter in Alonzo C. 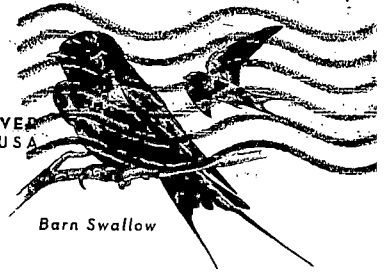
