MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Demetriss Glenn respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until March 15, 2021**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Demetriss Glenn respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel will file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Lee Corley with the Court of Appeals today, February 12, 2021. Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Hollis Brock v. State with the Supreme Court on February 5, 2021. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Roderquiz Cook v. State with the Supreme Court on January 14, 2021. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. David L. Steadman with the Court of Appeals on December 14, 2020. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Dale Eugene King with the Court of Appeals on December 1, 2020. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Carl Aiken v. State with the Supreme Court on November 23, 2020. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Douglas Lavance Young with the Court of Appeals on November 12, 2020. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Otis Gibson with the Court of Appeals on November 4, 2020. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Joanie Holcombe v. State with the Supreme Court on October 30, 2020.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, has graciously consented to this extension request by way of the thirty day general consent granted by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through February 28, 2021. That emailed general consent was dated January 26, 2021.


