APPELLANT’S SECOND MOTION FOR EXTENSION

Appellant Estate at Westbury Owners Association, Inc. (“Estate at Westbury”) respectfully requests that it be given a 30-day extension (to March 29, 2021) in which to file its initial brief. The reason for this request is that the undersigned counsel’s children and husband have contracted COVID-19, and she must quarantine at home for 14 days with those children, her other child, her husband, and the dog, to care for them and to monitor whether she and the rest of the family develop symptoms, as well as manage on-line school for the multiple quarantined children.
