## ORDER

Appellant has filed a first motion, which this court construes as a request for an extension of time to cure the deficiencies in his initial brief. Appellant's request for an extension of time is granted. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended initial brief and designation of matter that complies with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. To the extent Appellant requests this court mail him back his original deficient filing, that request is denied.

Appellant has filed a second motion, which this court construes as a request to rehear the denial of Appellant's motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. That request is denied. See Rule 240(i), SCACR ("The court will not entertain petitions for rehearing on a motion or petition unless the action of the court on the motion or petition has the effect of dismissing or finally deciding a party's appeal."). Appellant shall pay the notice of appeal filing fee within ten days of the date of this order or this appeal will be dismissed.
