Regardless of the Court's order based on foreign rules;



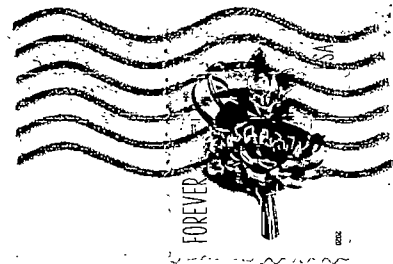
