**MOTION TO ALLOW FILING OF
SUPPLEMENTAL RECORD ON APPEAL**

Respondent (“the State”), through its undersigned counsel, would respectfully show unto the Court as follows:

I.

Appellant William D. Lewis’s appeal is currently pending before this Court. At this time, all briefing is complete, the briefs and record have been submitted, and the matter is scheduled for oral argument before this Court on March 2, 2021, at 10:00 a.m.

II.

In preparing for the oral argument, undersigned counsel for the State discovered while reviewing the Record on Appeal that two pages of the trial transcript—page 597 and page 989—were inadvertently omitted from the Record on Appeal as filed. Both the State and Appellant

Appellant designated numerous pages of the trial transcript for inclusion in the Record on Appeal, and the pages designated by both parties included page 597 and page 989 from the trial transcript.

III.

Because properly designated matter was inadvertently omitted from the Record on Appeal, the State believes it is necessary to file a Supplemental Record on Appeal containing the inadvertently omitted matter. See Rule 210(c), SCACR (“The Record on Appeal shall include all matter designated to be included by any party under Rule 209[.]”). Accordingly, the State asks this Court to permit and accept the filing of a Supplemental Record on Appeal containing the designated matter inadvertently omitted from the Record on Appeal.

IV.


