MOTION TO WITHDRAW


COMES NOW the undersigned attorney of record for the Appellant, Lloyd J. Drayton, and prays this Court to enter its order granting leave to withdraw as counsel for the Appellant herein and as grounds therefore would show the Court:

1. That I, Sharon B. Capers, was previously retained to represent Appellant in General Sessions Court on the Charges of Driving Under the Influence and Assault on a Public Official. Representation of the Appellant ended at the General Sessions level and did not include Appeals.
2. Appellant was convicted of Assault on a Public Official and sentenced to three years imprisonment. He indicated his desire to appeal the convictions.
3. I advised Appellant that I did not handle Appellate cases but completed documents for him to file Pro Se in order to preserve his rights until he retained counsel.

4. I advised the Court by phone and letter several times that I did not represent the Appellant. Further, several attorneys contacted me regarding Appellant and I understood per Appellant that he had retained counsel to handle this Appeal.
5. I was subsequently Ordered to file the Appeal for the Appellant as there was apparently no other Attorney of Record. I filed the Appeal for the Defendant as required by Order of the Appellate Court.
6. Appellant did not retain me to handle this Appeal nor did he request that I represent him on this Appeal.
7. I do not represent the Appellant and have not had contact with him in more than a year.

For the foregoing reasons, Counsel believes that she is entitled to withdraw from representation of the Appellant.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned prays that this Court enter its order allowing withdrawal herein.


