While this Court had not received it earlier, yesterday, the South Carolina Court of Appeals provided this Court with a copy of your petition for a writ of certiorari. This petition is dated January 28, 2021, and was received by the Court of Appeals, on February 4, 2021, in an envelope post-marked February 2, 2021.

This Court has also received your motion for an extension of time dated February 23, 2021.


As you know, the Court of Appeals denied the petition for rehearing in this case on December 22, 2020. Therefore, any petition for a writ of certiorari had to be served and filed on or before January 22, 2021. Rule 242(c) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. When this did not occur, the Court of Appeals sent the remittitur on February 3, 2021.

The sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction over this case, and no further motion or petition can be considered by either appellate court. *Stogsdill v. S.C. Dep't of Health & Human Servs.*, 415 S.C. 568, 784 S.E.2d 669 (2016); *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007). Therefore, no action will be taken on petition for a writ of certiorari or motion for an extension.
