MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME IN WHICH TO SERVE

Pursuant to Rule 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the undersigned attorney, counsel for appellant, Glenn Edwin Vanover, files this motion for an extension of the deadline for serving and filing the appellant's initial brief and designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal, and in support of this motion says as follows:

one extension of this deadline. The initial brief and designation are now due to be served and filed March 25, 2013.



WHEREFORE, counsel hereby respectfully asks for a 30-day extension of time in which to serve and file the appellant's initial brief and designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal, until April 24, 2013.


