Dear Ms. Kitchings:

In response to my letter dated January 25, 2021, the Court graciously granted me an additional thirty-day extension within which to file Respondents' Brief in the above case, until March 8, 2021. This letter is to request an additional ten-day extension. I have conferred with opposing counsel, who graciously does not oppose this request.

My reason for the first extension was because of an injury I sustained shortly before the date of that letter, in which I had suffered six broken ribs and a punctured lung. Whereas I had optimistically written in my previous letter that I should return to my office by February 1, 2021, I must report that I have not yet been able to do so, because of the physical constraints involving my injury and recovery.

I regret having to make this additional request. However, as I have stated, my recovery time has been longer than I had anticipated.


