Pursuant to Rule 208(b)(7), SCACR, Cliff Eubanks calls this Court's attention to the following cases, which are relevant to Questions I and II:

1. *Chappell v. State*, 429 S.C. 68, 78, 837 S.E.2d 496, 501 (Ct. App. 2019) ("Galloway-Williams' statement not only had the effect of improperly bolstering the victim's credibility; it also improperly invaded the province of the jury to determine the only issue in this case: whether Chappell sexually abused the victim.").
2. *State v. Makins*, 428 S.C. 440, 448-49, 835 S.E.2d 532, 537 (Ct. App. 2019) ("We find Rich's opinion testimony addressing the various manifestations of child sexual abuse, followed immediately by her affirmative response that she treated Victim, implied she believed Victim was telling the truth with respect to her allegations of sexual abuse. If Rich believed Victim had not been telling the truth, Rich would not have needed to treat her.").
