Respondent's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter.**


**The Court negligence and slackness in this matter has been prejudicial

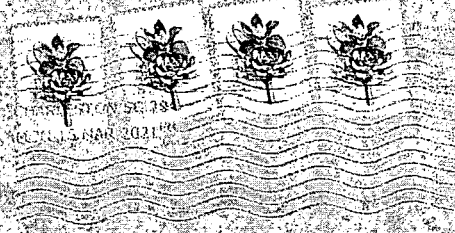
