
The Defendant, Travis Gathers,

Defendant's Affidavit  
in Support for

Defendant, Travis Gathers, file this affidavit in support of his motion for Leave to Supplement the record.

The motion seeks an order permitting the Defendant to Supplement the record on appeal to this Court.

### Case History

On February 25, 2021, a Schmeber hearing was held by the Honorable

Daniel Hall. The order requires the Defendant to submit to a second taking of DNA by the State.

On March 4, 2021, the Defendant filed with the Clerk of the Court a Notice of Appeal from the order which is currently pending.

In Supplemental of the Record

The Defendant submit that the record of the proceeding does not include information that was calculated by the State to deprive the Court of intelligence essential to the case. Minimal testimony was offered by the State in reference to a Smith & Wesson M&P 9mm handgun that was recovered in a parking lot on July 16, 2020, and DNA collected from the Defendant on July 21, 2020 through a defective search warrant.

First Request: Based on the initial Forensic Laboratory report on July 20, 2020, Technician Emily Campbell-Smith had analyzed a total of thirteen (13) DNA profiles that was collected from the magazine, trigger, and grip of the Smith & Wesson M&P 9mm handgun (Forensic Laboratory Report Dated July 20, 2020 Exhibit A).

Second Request: On July 21, 2020, Magistrate Douglas Sexton issued a Search Warrant to collect the Defendant's DNA, and a reference DNA Swab (Y20-00651) was obtained by Officer Devin Ashew. Detective Joey Wallace and Captain Carson Neely witnessed Officer Ashew conduct the extraction of DNA via buccal swab from the mouth of the Defendant at approximately 4:30 pm, pursuant to the Warrant (Search Warrant Dated July 21, 2020 Exhibit B).

Third Request: The reference DNA Swab (Y20-00651) was not submitted in the evidence room until July 31, 2020, at 9:50:35 am by another officer named Traylor Barbie at the York County Sheriff's Office. The reference swab was then received by Joslyn Bryn at the York County Sheriff's Office Forensic Biology and placed in storage at the Forensic Biology evidence room. The Defendant's DNA reference swab was missing and untraceable for approximately 10 days and 5 1/2 hours after it was obtained on July 21, 2020, and neither of the officers from the extraction process submitted that reference swab (Chain of Custody report reference swab (Y20-00651) Exhibit C).

Fourth Request: On August 11, 2020, Technician Emily Campbell-Smith conducted an examination of the

Defendant's DNA reference swab (Y20-00651) and a final DNA Laboratory report was submitted on January 20, 2021 following the exam (Forensic Laboratory Report Dated January 20, 2021 Exhibit D).

Fifth Request: On February 4, 2021, Assistant Solicitor Christopher Epting was notified through an email sent to him by Ms. Campbell-Smith that the DNA work on the reference sample from the Defendant was completed and a Schmecker hearing to obtain his DNA would not be necessary (Email Dated February 4, 2021 Exhibit E).

Sixth Request: On February 8, 2021, Ms. Campbell-Smith prepared the Forensic discovery packet and a complete copy of the discovery was provided to Mr. Epting in response to the email by Ms. Campbell-

Smith on February 4, 2021. The packet include a copy of the Chain of Custody report relating to the DNA reference swab (Y20-00651) that was taken with a Search Warrant (see Chain of Custody report Exhibit C).

The Defendant submit that serious action should be taken by this Court under the evidence demonstrating Mr. Epting was fully aware, by the Chain of Custody report, that the DNA collected from the Defendant on July 21, 2020 was never placed in evidence until July 31, 2020. Mr. Epting then acted in bad faith. He abused the application for a Schmebler hearing to have that DNA sample disposed to conceal that it was altogether missing and taken by officer Askew, Detective Wallace, and Captain Neely for approximately 10 days and 5 1/2 hours without any trace of the Defendant's DNA.

As well, this shows Mr. Epting only has a tremendously strong preference to cover up any and all of the bad acts these officers or other officers committed with the Defendant's DNA as it was totally in their possession and control for a significant time period to permit some injustice, as so.

This form of Prosecutorial Misconduct has critically tainted this case, as a whole. There is a very serious unknowing of who had their hands on the Defendant's DNA, where was his DNA, and what they did with his DNA that Mr. Epting could not answer and he attempted to evade by erecting the Schmerber hearing right after Ms. Campbell-Smith gave him notice that that hearing was not needed.


There is an important need of the Court to deter this conduct. Not

only does this practice impose on the Defendant's innocence and prejudice his rights but, if left unchecked, it would condemn the faith in equal protection that is promised by this State and our United States Government. It will also encourage others to believe that such conduct by officials would go unpunished or overlooked.

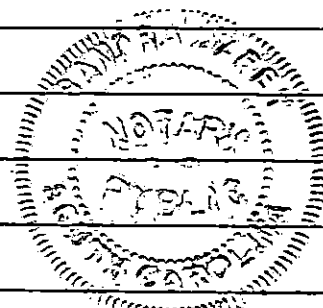
### Conclusion



Items 1-3 were analyzed using the polymerase chain reaction (PCR) and the Applied Biosystems GlobalFiler™ kit. GlobalFiler™ targets amelogenin, Y InDel, DYS391 and the following Short Tandem Repeat (STR) loci: D3S1358, vWA, D16S539, CSF1PO, TPOX, D8S1179, D21S11, D18S51, D2S441, D19S433, TH01, FGA, D22S1045, D5S818, D13S317, D7S820, SE33, D10S1248, D1S1656, D12S391, and D2S1338.

### Conclusions:

The DNA profile obtained from the swab of the base of the magazine (Item 1) is consistent with a mixture of at least four individuals. The partial major DNA profile is from an unidentified male source. No conclusions can be offered regarding the minor DNA profile.

The DNA profile obtained from the swab of the trigger (Item 2) is consistent with a mixture of at least four individuals. The major DNA profile is from an unidentified male source. No conclusions can be offered regarding the minor DNA profile.

The DNA profile obtained from the swab of the grip (Item 3) is consistent with a mixture of at least five individuals. The major DNA profile is from an unidentified male source. No conclusions can be offered regarding the minor DNA profile.

The major DNA profiles obtained from Items 1-3 are consistent.

The DNA profile from the swab of the trigger (Item 2) will be entered in the COMbined DNA Index System (CODIS) in

The affiant, Detective J.M. Wallace who is a certified law enforcement officer assigned to the York County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Division Violent Crime Unit and has several years of experience, including criminal investigations, states the following facts to support probable cause to search the records listed within:

On 6/28/2020 Deputies with the York County Sheriff's Office responded to the Bojangles, located at 4927 Charlotte Highway, Clover, York County, South Carolina in reference to a Armed Robbery. Upon arrival Deputies met with the victims inside the Bojangles who stated that a black male suspect entered the building by using a rock to bust the glass door. The suspect entered the building and robbed the manager and employees at gunpoint. The suspect was wearing dark colored clothing, with a dark colored mask, and carrying a black in color handgun. The suspect took money from the safe, took the employees cellular devices and forced them into the freezer. The suspect then left on foot leaving through the same door he entered. According to a witness, the suspect crossed over Charlotte Highway headed towards the entrance to a nearby apartment complex. Video surveillance was recovered from the inside and outside of the Bojangles.

On 7/10/2020 Deputies with the York County Sheriff's Office responded to the Wendys located at 5188 Charlotte Highway, Clover, York County, South Carolina in reference to an Armed Robbery. Upon arrival Deputies met with the victims inside of Wendys who stated that a black male entered the building by using a rock to bust the door glass door, and robbed the manager and employees at gunpoint. The suspect was dressed in dark colored clothing, with a dark colored mask, and carrying a black in color handgun. The suspect took money from the safe and fled the business. No video surveillance was available from the business.

On 7/12/2020 Deputies with the York County Sheriff's Office responded to the Wendys located at 1800 Highway 160, Fort Mill, York County, South Carolina in reference to an Armed Robbery. Upon arrival Deputies met with the victims inside of Wendys who stated that a black male entered the building through an open back door where a truck was being unloaded. The black male was armed with a handgun. As the black male forced the truck driver inside of the back door, a shot was fired striking the wall. The shell casing was recovered and entered into NIBIN for comparison. The black male suspect was wearing a blue shirt, camo shorts, and a tan hat. The suspect took money from the safe and fled the business. Video surveillance was provided from the manager's office showing the clothing of the suspect.

7/17/20

On 7/16/2020 Officers with the Rock Hill Police Department responded to the Wendys located at 1758 Heckle Boulevard, Rock Hill, York County, South Carolina in reference to a Armed Robbery. Upon arrival Officers met with the victims who stated that a black male suspect wearing dark colored clothing entered the building by busting the glass door with a rock. The victims inside stated that the black male suspect was armed with a handgun. Officers on scene located several cash drawers and a Smith and Wesson M&P 9mm handgun laying the parking lot of a nearby business. The handgun was swabbed for DNA and fingerprinted. The DNA was processed by the York County Sheriff's Office DNA Lab and sent to SLED for comparison. The fingerprint recovered on the magazine was entered in AFIS by Director George Weeks with YCMFSU. The firearm was taken to SLED for examination and comparison to the shell casing recovered in the Wendys Armed Robbery in Fort Mill, South Carolina on 7/12/2020. SLED firearms laboratory confirmed that the shell casing recovered from the Wendys Armed Robbery in Fort Mill was fired by the Smith and Wesson M&P 9mm recovered at this incident.


On 7/17/2020 Officers with the Rock Hill Police Department responded to the Arbys located at 1673 Cranium Drive, Rock Hill, York County, South Carolina in reference to an Armed Robbery. Upon arrival Officers met with the victims inside the Arbys who stated that a black male entered to the building through the unlocked side door. The victims described the suspect to be wearing dark colored clothing and a dark color mask. The victims stated that the suspect was armed with a straight edged knife, similar to a kitchen knife. The victims stated that the suspect took the money till from the drive thru register, and also money from the safe. The victim stated that the suspect exited the store through the side door. Detectives with Rock Hill Police and the York County Sheriff's Office canvassed the area for video surveillance. Video surveillance located at the Arbys as well as the storage facility nearby show a vehicle that appears to be a dark colored Mercedes circling the parking lot just before the robbery occurred. The vehicle parked on the side of the roadway near Arbys, and flees the area a short time later. Video surveillance was obtained from a nearby Walgreens as well showing the vehicle fleeing the area.

On 7/19/2020 Deputies with the York County Sheriff's Office responded to the McDonalds located at 5262 Highway 557, Clover, York County, South Carolina in reference to a Armed Robbery. Upon arrival deputies met with the victims who stated that they arrived at 4am. The victims stated that they unlocked the door to open for business at 5am. The victims stated that a short time later, the suspect entered the building and was standing behind her at the fryers. The victim stated that the suspect was a black male, wearing dark colored clothing, armed with a straight edged knife. The victim stated that he forced her back to the office and made her open the safe. The victim stated that the suspect took money from the safe, including a money box, bank money bags, coins, and cash. The victim stated that the suspect left through the side door.

Based on Detective J.M. Wallace's training, experience and evidence collected by YCMFSU and RHPD FSU it is believed that the recovery of this information listed above will aid in this investigation and possible prosecution of any and all possible suspect(s). I hereby determine and find probable cause to believe Travis Lamont Gathers has committed a crime and clear indication that relevant material evidence will be found and the method used is safe and reliable. I find that the necessity for this evidence outweighs all constitutional safeguards and find this to be a lawful search and seizure with minimal bodily intrusion.

### Results/Conclusions

The major DNA profile obtained from the swab of the trigger (Y20-00533 Item 2) matches the DNA profile obtained for Travis Gathers (Y20-00651 Item 1). The probability of randomly selecting an unrelated individual with a DNA profile matching that obtained is approximately 1 in greater than 7 trillion (approximately 1.000 times the world population).



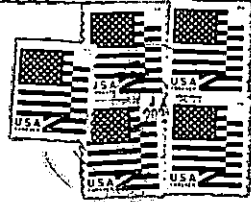
