Good Afternoon,

As you may know, we represent the Respondent, David Casey, in the above-referenced appeal. We are preparing to submit a formal motion to stay the proceedings on appeal because the current appeal is an almost interlocutory issue regarding back-owed benefits, and there are pending lower court proceedings in this same case regarding permanent impairment/award that, regardless of the outcome, will result in an appeal by one side or the other (and end up in the Court of Appeals). We do not believe either side would be prejudiced by staying the current appellate proceedings, as Appellants are not required to take any action regarding the appealed Order at this time. In the interest of judicial economy, we feel it would be better to wait until both issues are before the court and not have two concurrent appeals on the same case going through the appellate process.
