NOTICE OF APPEAL

I, ROBERT WILLIAM WAZNEY, am in receipt of this Courts ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO DISMISS (ORDER) filed 2/22/21 which I received on or about 2/24/21, the ORDER states my appeal is dismissed pursuant to Al-Shabazz v. State because the appeal does not affect my sentence, sentence related credits, custody status, or good time credits, and does not invoke any state-created property rights.
