The Appellant's Motion for Rehearing

The appellant Derrick Martin Miller pursuant to Rule 221 SCACR, moves the court to reconsider its 11th, March 2021 opinion. In support of the motion, the appellant shows the following to the court:

1. The court overlooked the Motion of Discovery the Burden of Proof has erroneously misapplied the reasonable doubt by prosecution and Judge Hayes in the following respects:

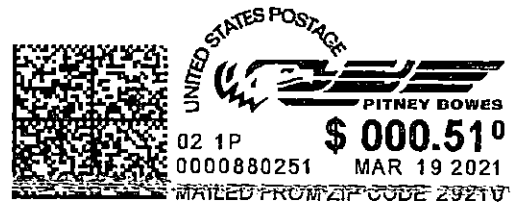
