NOTICE OF APPEAL

Anthony McKennie appeals his conviction and sentence in this case. On January 17, 2019, McKennie pled guilty to Voluntary Manslaughter and Possession of a Weapon by a Person Convicted of a Crime of Violence before the Honorable Edgar W. Dickson. On January 25, 2019, Judge Dickson sentenced McKennie to nineteen (19) years for Voluntary Manslaughter, to be served concurrently with a sentence of five (5) years for Possession of a Weapon by a Person Convicted of a Crime of Violence. A Motion to Reconsider Sentence was filed and served February 4, 2019. On March 4, 2021, Judge Dickson held a hearing on the matter. On March 29, 2021, Judge Dickson filed his Order Denying Motion for Reconsideration of Sentence, a copy of which was received and scanned by Counsel for McKennie on March 30, 2021. 
