ORDER

Petitioner has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari to the court of appeals in which he claims error only in dismissing his allegations of ineffective assistance of counsel, which the court of appeals denied without discussion. *Brown v. State*, Op. No. 2020-UP-284 (S.C. Ct. App. filed Oct. 7, 2020). We decline to entertain the petition. *Ellison v. State*, 382 S.C. 189, 191, 676 S.E.2d 671, 672 (2009) (holding this Court will not entertain a petition for a writ of certiorari when the court of appeals has issued an order denying a writ of certiorari in a PCR matter).
