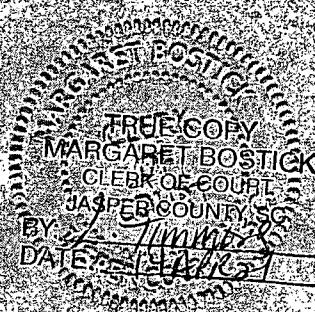

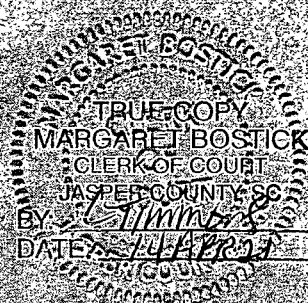
**Trafficking in Heroin, 4 grams or more, but less than 14 grams**

That in Jasper County, South Carolina, on or about June 11, 2018, the Defendant, Kareem Kenya Stevenson, did knowingly actually or constructively possess four grams or more, but less than fourteen grams of a morphine, opium, salt, isomer, or salt of an isomer thereof, including heroin, as described in Section 44-53-190 or Section 44-53-210, or a mixture containing any of these substances, to wit: Defendant was the passenger in a vehicle that was the subject of a traffic stop. Officer detected the odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle and awaited backup for a search as she was by herself. Defendant urged the driver to flee the scene of the stop and also tried to get out of the passenger side door. Backup Officer arrived as Defendant was trying to climb through the passenger side window in an effort to flee. A search of Defendant's person resulted in a lab test quantity of 5.92 grams of Heroin, all in violation of Section 44-53-370(e)(3)(a)(1), et al. of the Codes of Law of South Carolina.

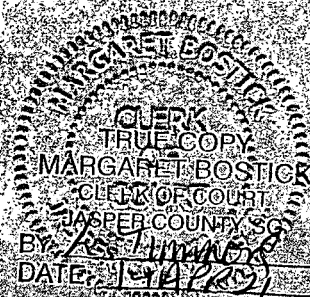

That in Jasper County, South Carolina, on or about June 11, 2018, the Defendant, Kareem Kenya Stevenson, did knowingly sell, manufacture, deliver, purchase, or otherwise bring into this State, or provide financial assistance or otherwise aid, abet, attempt, or conspire to sell, manufacture, deliver, purchase, or bring into this State, or was knowingly in actual or constructive possession of more than ten, but less than twenty-eight grams of methamphetamine or cocaine base as defined and otherwise limited in Section 44-53-110, 44-53-210(d)(1) or 44-53-210(d)(2) to wit: Defendant was the passenger in a vehicle that was the subject of a traffic stop. Officer detected the odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle and awaited backup for a search as she was by herself. Defendant urged the driver to flee the scene of the stop and also tried to get out of the passenger side door. Backup Officer arrived as Defendant was trying to climb through the passenger side window in an effort to flee. At a Court of General Sessions, convened on March 4, 2019, the Grand Jurors of Jasper County present upon their oath:


**Possession with Intent to Distribute Cocaine**

That in Jasper County, South Carolina, on or about June 11, 2018, the Defendant, Kareem Kenya Stevenson, did possess with the intent to manufacture, distribute, dispense, deliver, or purchase Cocaine, which was a controlled substance classified in Schedule I (b) or (c) which was a narcotic drug, or lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD), or in Schedule II which was a narcotic drug, to wit: Defendant was the passenger in a vehicle that was the subject of a traffic stop. Officer detected the odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle and awaited backup for a search as she was by herself. Defendant urged the driver to flee the scene of the stop and also tried to get out of the passenger side door. Backup Officer arrived as Defendant was trying to climb through the passenger side window in an effort to flee. A search of the vehicle resulted in finding a cigarette pack, located under the Defendant's seat, which contained a lab tested weight of 1.88 grams of Cocaine, all in violation of Section 44-53-370(b)(1), 44-53-370(a)(1), et al. of the Codes of Law of South Carolina.
