

ORDER

This appeal arises out of an order of the circuit court affirming the probate court and remanding. Because the underlying order is not immediately appealable, we dismiss this appeal. *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 62-1-308(a) (Supp. 2020) ("A person interested in a final order, sentence, or decree of a probate court may appeal to the circuit court in the same county, subject to the provisions of Section 62-1-303."); *Dorn v. Cohen*, 421 S.C. 517, 520, 809 S.E.2d 53, 54 (2017) (holding only final orders from the probate court are appealable under section 62-1-308). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
