THE DEFENDANTS VINCENT BEATON, NATHANIEL RAVENELL, LATEEF RAVENELL AND AHMADE WAHEED IS ACCUSED OF MURDER

That on February 26, 2005, at 1:20am officers responded to 1936 Stokes Dr. in reference to the murder of Clifton Anderson. Investigation revealed the victim was brought to the scene by the defendant Ahmade Waheed who he was driving the victim around all night. Detectives interviewed Waheed who withheld information about his involvement and information as to whom the shooter was. Waheed was arrested and interviewed some days later. During the second interview Waheed took detectives to the residence of an eyewitness to the murder and stated that this witness could identify the other defendants. Detectives interviewed Tyrone Jones who gave a statement stating the shooting was a set up conducted by the shooter who he only knows by sight, A.K.A. Snobby (Nathaniel Ravenell) and his brother A.K.A. Tazky (Lateef Ravenell). Detectives located and arrested the two Ravenell brothers based on the statement from Tyrone Jones. During an interview with Lateef Ravenell he stated that he could identify the shooter, but asked to speak with his lawyer about this before he advised detectives. Before the bond hearing detective Lateef's lawyer advised Elmore that the shooters name was Vincent Beaton A.K.A "Rod". Vincent Beaton was arrested the next day for the murder of Clifton Anderson. Lateef Ravenell and Tyrone Jones identified Vincent Beaton was the shooter from a photo line up.

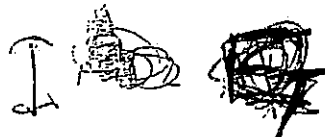

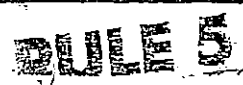
