Whereas, the Actual Standard set forth by the Parole Board's own governing policies § 2-20 Paroling Policy/Guidelines (1)(c), S. C. State Statute § 24-22-30(f)(g)(b)(c), Parole Criteria form 1212 and the Offender Management System that plays a vital role in the "Evaluation Process" of a prisoner's risk score, custody management, release eligibility, etc. etc.

Therefore, I'm formally Objecting to the enclosed Order handed down by the Admin. Law Court and seeking permission to submit a full brief concerning this matter.

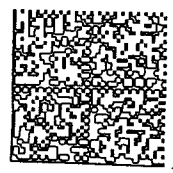

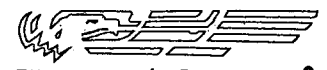
