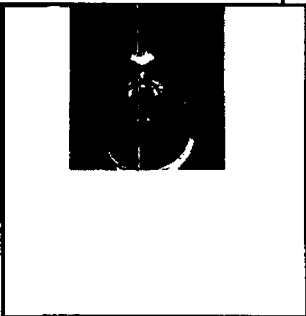

Personally appeared before me the affiant HOGUE, JK who being duly sworn deposes and says that defendant LEVY LARKIN BROWN did within this county and state on 07/15/2018 to 07/15/2018 violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina (or ordinance of  County/  Municipality of PORT ROYAL) in the following particulars:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: 16-11-0330(A) / ARMED ROBBERY

I further state that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime set forth and that probable cause is based on the following facts:

ON 07/15/2018 AT APPROXIMATELY 2245 HOURS, THE DEFENDANT, LEVY BROWN, AND A CO-DEFENDANT DID WILLFULLY AND INTENTIONALLY VIOLATE THE CRIMINAL LAWS OF THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA §16-11-0330 CDR: 0139 IN THE OFFENSE OF ARMED ROBBERY, IN THAT AFTER SCHEMING WITH AN EMPLOYEE, ENTERED THE CLOSED BUSINESS WEARING MASKS AND BRANDISHING WEAPONS. ONCE INSIDE, THE DEFENDANTS DEMANDED MONEY AND THE MANAGER WAS ACCOSTED. THE DEFENDANTS WERE ABLE TO STEAL AWAY APPROXIMATELY \$2600.00. 
