Good afternoon.

Following yesterday's filing of Appellant's Petition for Rehearing, the parties reached an agreement to resolve this case in its entirety.

As the Order outlining all settlement terms will need to be approved by the South Carolina Worker's Compensation Commission, counsel are jointly requesting further action on the pending Petition be held in abeyance pending consummation of this settlement.

While we do not envision any impediments to finalizing the settlement, holding this matter in abeyance will preserve the status quo until drafting, execution and filing of the settlement Order can be completed. This action would similarly afford Respondents an opportunity to file a return in the highly unlikely event settlement is not consummated.

I anticipate a draft settlement Order will be circulated to all counsel for review next week. Once it is fully executed, we will be forwarding it to the Commission for approval and filing.

We will certainly contact you upon receipt of the approved settlement Order to verify conclusion of this case.
