ORDER

First, the motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is denied pursuant to *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). The filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order.

Second, the motion to stay the writ of ejectment is denied. *See* Rule 241(b), SCACR (noting a writ of ejectment is not automatically stayed by the filing of a notice of appeal); *see also* Rule 241 ("Except where extraordinary circumstances make it impracticable, an application for an order lifting the automatic stay or for supersedeas must first be made to the lower court or administrative tribunal which entered the order or decision on appeal.").
