The trial of this case was held in the County of Marion in the Court of Common Pleas the week of April 26, 2021. A jury of citizens from Marion County heard this case pursuant to a request for a jury trial filed by the State. Assistant Attorney General Suzanne J. Shaw represented the State. James K. Falk, Esquire, represented the Petitioner. The jury having heard the presentation of the evidence made the following findings of fact pursuant to South Carolina Code Sections 44-48-10 through 44-48-110:

The State has proven beyond a reasonable doubt that Petitioner's mental abnormality or personality disorder remains such that he is not safe to be at large and, if released, is likely to engage in acts of sexual violence.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:


Petitioner Darryl Dewayne Garner is to remain committed to the Department of Mental Health for his long-term control, care and treatment.

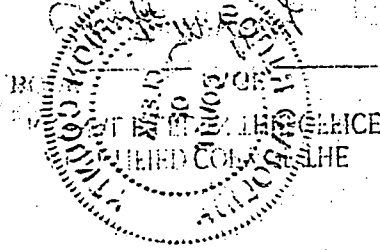
