This matter is before the Court on Defendant South Carolina Department of Education's Motion to Alter or Amend Order or Motion to Reconsider, which it filed pursuant Rule 59(e), SCRCF, on January 25, 2021. Defendant's motion was filed in response to the Court's Order entered January 13, 2021, wherein the Court denied Defendant's Motion to Set Aside Entry of Default and Motion to Dismiss, and further ordered the matter be referred to the Master-in-Equity for the purposes of a damages hearing.
