Dear Mr. Ceo:

This responds to your letter dated May 18, 2021 in which you state you submitted a Rule 243(c) Explanation together with your notice of appeal. This office did not receive a Rule 243(c) Explanation together with your notice of appeal.

Accordingly, I request that you provide a Rule 243(c) Explanation within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter.

Furthermore, and as explained in the Clerk of Court's Letter of May 3, 2021, since you have filed multiple post-conviction relief applications challenging the underlying criminal conviction(s), the Court, if it determines that you have failed to provide an adequate explanation under Rule 243(c), SCACR, may decide to prohibit you from filing a post-conviction relief application, habeas corpus action or any other action, motion or petition in the circuit court challenging this conviction(s) and sentence(s) (including a motion under Rule 29 of the South Carolina Rules of Criminal Procedure) without first obtaining the permission of this Court to do so. If you believe that there is some reason(s) why such a

prohibition should not be imposed on future filings by you in the circuit court, those reasons should also be provided within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter.
