## ORDER

Respondents move to serve and file the brief of respondents out of time and for an extension of twenty days, to June 4, 2021, to serve and file the brief. Petitioners consent to both motions.

The motions to file out of time and for an extension of time are granted. However, this is respondents' second motion to file their brief out of time and the third extension granted to respondent in this case. Ordinarily, a party may be granted extensions totaling no more than twenty days during proceedings under Rule 242, SCACR, and extensions beyond twenty days are permitted based only on "extraordinary circumstances such as illness or other circumstances beyond the control of the movant [that] warrant the granting of the extension." *See* Order of the Supreme Court of South Carolina dated July 16, 2014 (<http://www.sccourts.org/whatsnew/displaywhatsnew.cfm?indexID=963>).
