Dear Shirley,

As you requested, I submitted your application for permission to appeal to the South Carolina Supreme Court. Without any explanation, the court returned your application to me, first marked as filed Mar 15, 2013, then marked "refused for filing (illegible) cc8nL).

It appears that South Carolina does not have a state remedy in your case, in that your filing was arbitrarily refused. Given that the Post-Conviction Relief Act encompasses habeas corpus (Const. Art 1, S. 18, Code 1976, SS 17-27-10 to 120), and under United States Statute 28 U.S.C.A. 2242 ("someone acting in his behalf" clause) you are permitted to ask someone to mail in your application, and are permitted assistance (Johnson v. Avery, 393 U.S. 483, 89 S.Ct. 747), I might suggest that you proceed to seek habeas corpus relief in the United States Court.

Please advise me of your thoughts on this matter.

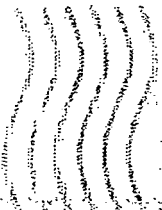
