
NOTICE OF MOTION TO APPEAL ORDER
HOLDING CARRIE COLEMAN IN CONTEMPT
OF COURT AND ORDERING DETENTION

IN THIS PROBATE ACTION, CARRIE COLEMAN WOULD LIKE TO APPEAL THE COURT ORDER HOLDING HER IN CONTEMPT OF COURT AND ORDERING DETENTION IN THE MATTER OF THE ESTATE OF JESSICA SHEILA COLEMAN.

CARRIE COLEMAN WAS APPOINTED PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ESTATE OF JESSICA SHEILA COLEMAN BY ALL HEIRS. THE PROBATE COURT DETERMINED AN JUDGEMENT TO THE ESTATE OF MALCOLM RAY COLEMAN AND CARRIE MAKIYA SMITH. AN ATTORNEY WAS OBTAINED, PROPER ACCOUNTING AND A PROPOSAL WAS PREPARED, ALONG WITH \$5, 033.76 BEING PAID TOWARD JUDGEMENT PRIOR TO THE DUE DATE AND ALL GOOD FAITH EFFORTS WERE DENIED. THE ESTATE FOR MALCOLM RAY COLEMAN IS NON-EXISTENT AND THE PAYMENT WAS ATTRIBUTED SOLELY TO THAT ENTITY. CARRIE MAKIYA SMITH SIGNED A WAIVER THAT WAS DENIED AND STATED DURING THE ZOOM THAT SHE WAS NOT CONCERNED ABOUT ANY MONEY. THERE WERE MORTGAGE PAYMENTS MADE AS WELL AS AN HEIR BEING REMOVED.

WE WOULD LIKE TO SEE THE "CLEAR AND CONVINCING EVIDENCE PROVING THAT SHE IS ACTING UNDER CONSTRUCTIVE CIVIL CONTEMPT." SHE HAS DONE EVERYTHING ASKED OF HER, ALTHOUGH HER TIMING MAY NOT BE AS IT SHOULD. MS. COLEMAN HAS BATTLED COVID-19 PERSONALLY AND AS A FRONTLINE WORKER IN THE MEDICAL FIELD. MS. COLEMAN ADVISED THE COURT THAT SHE DID NOT HAVE THE FUNDS TO PAY THE TOTAL AMOUNT, BUT IF EVIDENCE INDEED PROVED SHE OWED ANY HEIRS SHE WOULD MAKE THINGS RIGHT. MS. COLEMAN WAS TOLD SHE COULD NOT MAKE PAYMENTS TOWARD THE JUDGEMENT, SHE WOULD HAVE TO PAY THE TOTAL JUDGEMENT IN FULL OR BE DETAINED UNTIL PAYMENT IS MADE. MS. COLEMAN IS SIMPLY SEEKING COMPASSION AND RECONSIDERATION IN THIS MATTER IN THE INTEREST OF JUSTICE FOR ALL PARTIES INVOLVED. WE ASK THAT THE COURT RECONSIDER ALL EVIDENCE PROVIDED TO REACH A DECISION THAT IS REASONABLE. AN INDETERMINATE DETENTION WILL NOT RESOLVE THE ISSUE AT HAND.
