ORDER


Appellant's motion to strike Respondents' motion to dismiss this appeal is denied. However, after careful consideration, Respondents' motion to dismiss this appeal is denied. Respondents' alternative motion to strike the record on appeal and compel Appellant to serve and file an amended record on appeal is granted.

Within ten days of this order, Respondents shall provide Appellant with a copy of the following documents listed in Respondents' designations of matter: (1) Woody Law Firm and Carrie Boyer's items 12, 26 (Exhibits), 29 (Exhibits), 28 (Exhibit F-1), 34, and 38; (2) Allison Williams and First Federal's item 22 (Exhibits); and (3) Stephen Dudek, Doreen Cross, Michael Scarafile, Susan Nicholson and Carolina One Real Estate's items 10 and 11.¹ Upon receipt, Appellant shall compile an amended record on appeal that includes *all* of the items designated in Respondents' designations of matter.² Appellant shall serve and file

¹ Appellant has indicated she was unable to obtain a copy of these items because the items were not included in the lower court record or because Respondents' designations did not clearly identify the items.

² The amended record on appeal shall not be limited to the specific items listed in this order; rather, the amended record shall include all items listed in the parties' designations of matter.

the amended record on appeal within thirty days of this order. Failure to comply with this order may result in the dismissal of this appeal.
